


WHAT'S HAPPENING ON-SITE

At the start of the month, we established the site compound, which is now situated on the east side of Staple Lane opposite Jericho Road. Within the compound, a solar pod has been installed to reduce our carbon emissions through solar energy and optimised power usage management.

Our works to Staple Lane commenced on the 21st August and will run through until November 2024. We have begun work at the west side of the junction to Jericho Road and will continue down Staple Lane. This road will be completely closed for the duration of the project, and this will also include the footpaths. Therefore, for safety, there will be no pedestrian or cyclist access allowed within this area. Diversion routes for pedestrians and cyclists have been circulated.
